## Pine Creek Trail Hike

When: Saturday, May 19th, 2007

Where: Enjoy this Red Rock Area hike to Pine Creek where Ponderosa pines and flowing water will take your breath away.

\* Moderate, 3 miles.

When/Where to meet: 8:00 am at the Starbucks at Town Center and West Charleston.

What to bring: We will be car pooling from Starbucks. Water, camera, hiking boots; comfortable hiking clothes. Bring your Red Rock pass (if you have one); otherwise there will be a small fee to enter the Red Rock Park.

After the Hike: For those that want to, we will stop and have a mid-day snack and beverage at BJ's Brewery on Charleston

#### PINE CREEK CANYON:

Take the trail downhill from the parking lot, following it toward the canyon. The trail is intersected twice by the Fire Ecology Trail and by Dale's Trail, then forks near the old Wilson homestead foundation. This part of the trail is a loop

and is easier to follow to the left where it goes downhill, across a stream, then uphill to the intersection of the Arnight *Trail.* Continue up the canyon crossing the wash, and eventually return to the main trail on the opposite side of the homestead. Follow it back to the parking lot. (2. 9 mile round trip, moderate).



### **June 22nd- 24th. 2007 (Friday – Sunday)**

This is a great get-a-way from the Las Vegas heat. We have a group site reservation at the North Rim campground. This campsite is designed for tent camping....If you wish to RV camp, please contact Dave for more info.

The cost will be \$10.00 per person, which includes both nights.

- There is an additional Park fee of \$25.00 per vehicle to enter the park.
- There is laundry and showers located near the campground for a fee.
- Groceries/Camping Supplies: Supplies can be purchased at the General Store adjacent to the North Rim Campground

The park is unmatched in the vistas it offers and is located in Northern Arizona. The drive is approximately 5-6 hours, depending upon your style. Watch out for the speed trap in Hilsdale, UT. (personal experience)..... Plus, if you want to chat with an Arizona trooper, a speeding ticket will cost you about \$130.00.

From Las Vegas, NV - 264 miles / 425 kilometers Take I-15 Northeast to Highway 9 just north of St. George. Take Highway 9 east to Highway 89. Take Highway 89 south to Highway 89Alt. Take Highway 89Alt east to Highway 67. Take Highway 67 south directly to the North Rim.

The average temps are 75/daytime and 50/nighttime.

There is normally a group hike on Saturday that some members participate in but even if you don't feel the urge, there are smaller walks and other activities to indulge your tastes. — Come join our campfire.

## Bylaw change proposal

Sometimes the business nature of our club changes and the rules and policies of the Club need to adapt also. Such is the case of Bylaw Article 5.4 governing the selection of the Trip Director. The Board of Directors has assessed the needs of the Club and wishes to submit a proposal to change and enhance the wording of bylaw 5.4. We feel the current Club Bylaw is too restrictive for the smooth ongoing management of the club. The old and new wording change is listed below.

The bylaws of the Club dictate that a change proposal be published in the newsletter at least 30 days prior to a vote. Due to the timing of the NL being published and the general meetings being held, that will mean we will vote on this change at the May 16th General meeting.

If you have questions or concerns, please feel free to contact Dave Berry or any one of the Board.

#### **ARTICLE V - Committees**

OLD: 5.4 The Trip Director must be an officer of the club and shall sign all trip contracts subject to the approval of the Board of Directors.

NEW: 5.4 The Trip Director shall be appointed from the Board of Directors by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

- 5.4.1 The Trip Director shall have responsibility for organizing a trip committee for the purpose of establishing the coming year's planned winter and off-season trips for the club.
- 5.4.2 The Trip director shall submit to the Board all planned trips and request approval to sell the trips to the club membership.
- 5.4.3 The Trip Director shall have responsibility for and sign or approve all trip contracts subject to the approval of the Board of Directors.
- 5.4.4 The Trip Director shall have approval authority of all Trip leaders volunteering to lead a trip. A Trip leader must be an active club member. Other trip leader qualifications are based upon experience, fiscal responsibility & motivation to sell the trip.
