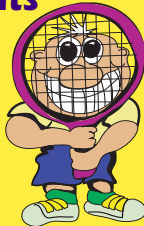

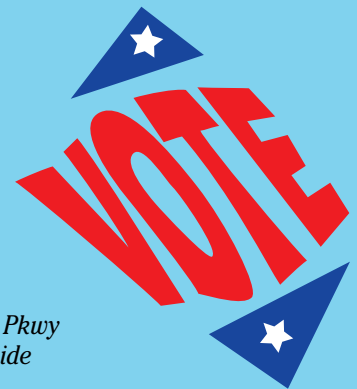

When: Saturday, March 15, 2008

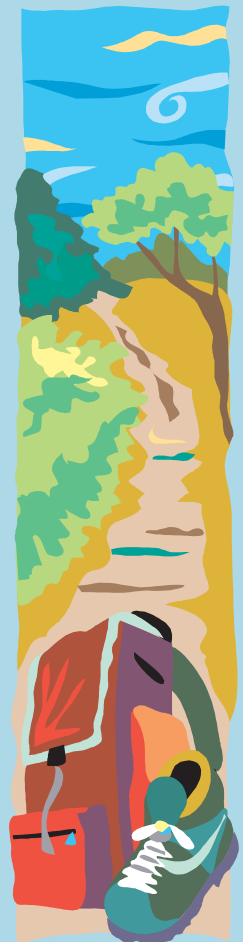

Overview: A popular hike at Red Rock Canyon, is the 3-mile trail to Pine Creek where in 1920, Horace and Glenda Wilson were inspired to build a two-story house. In 1976, the Nevada State Parks acquired the property where hikers can go and view the remaining foundation. The canyon in Pine Creek is a Wilderness Study Area with unique conditions that are believed to mimic what Las Vegas Valley may have been like less than a million years ago. The riparian (water-fed) area is home to flora found in cooler climes like Ponderosa pine trees and the manzanita.
