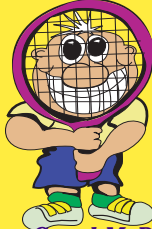

## Mary Jane Falls Trail Hike

Enjoy this Mt. Charleston hike to Mary Jane Falls where the canyon is deep, forested, and surrounded by beautiful gray limestone cliffs. Moderate, 3 miles.

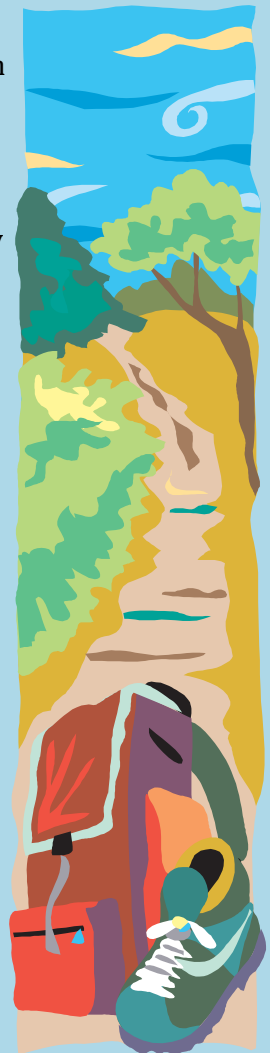
**When:** Saturday, June 14th, 2008

**Overview:** This trail is the most popular trail in Mt Charleston. A short hike utilizing switchbacks (12) and stone steps on a very well marked and heavily used trail. There is a nice size cave along the N cliff, to the left of the falls on the left, with an easy to follow path leading to the mouth of the cave. From the base of the falls you can see Big Falls to the West, and Charleston Peak in the background. This is a pretty trail with ponderosa pines, white fir, aspen, and mountain mahogany. Look for deer and fox in the aspens at sunrise and sunset, near the beginning /end of trail. Hike early to avoid the crowds at Mary Jane Falls.

The mine tour is in the historical Techatticup Mine, the oldest richest and most famous gold mine in Southern Nevada. Just 45 minutes outside of Las Vegas you'll experience a historical mine tour and scenic bluewater kayak trip on the Colorado River at the mouth of Black Canyon below the Hoover Dam.

The guided above and below tour includes a walking tour of the old Techatticup millsite then proceeding into the Savage Mine some 500ft. THE AIR TEMP IN THE MINE IS A COOL 70 DEGREES. We will then take our 1 or 2 man kayaks down to launch at Nelson Landing. While paddling, swimming and exploring the coves in the refreshing 82 degree water we will be on the look out for burros and big horn sheep!
