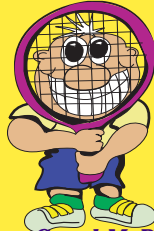

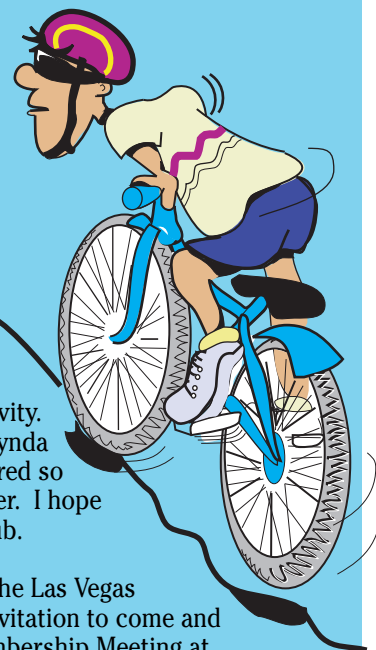

## Travel Safety

With everyone gearing up for their summer vacations, please take a few minutes and think about safety on your trip.

By getting your vehicle checked thoroughly, especially the tires, it will be one less possibility to ruin what should be a fun time. And don't forget the spare. Living in the desert has a tendency to shorten the life of batteries. If it is more than 3 years old, think seriously about replacing it before you leave.

As part of your safety travel kit, include plenty of drinking water, at least one gallon for each passenger, which can also be used for radiator water in an emergency. The Automobile Association of America, AAA, website has lists for essential items to take with you.

However, if you are traveling by air, train, bus, or ship, use common sense when choosing what to pack. Take only the valuables (credit cards, store charge cards, jewelry, etc) you will need. Also, think about leaving social security cards, pictures, membership cards at home. In other words, purge your wallets, purses, and fanny packs.

Another point your board of directors would like to share. With energy prices soaring, don't cancel long term travel plans, like the upcoming ski season. Call ahead of time. In some cases, tour bus operators will hit you with a fuel surcharge just before boarding.

## Bristlecone Loop Lee Canyon

*Trail & Hike Rated Moderate. This hike is a favorite for hiker and dog alike. The plant and wildlife diversity, as well as the views along the trail, keep the hike interesting. The following overview is courtesy of [www.birdandkike.com](http://www.birdandkike.com)*

**When:** Saturday, July 19th, 2008

**When/Where to Meet:** 8:00 am at the McDonalds Parking Lot. Northbound on Hwy 95 at Craig Road, Left on Craig, McD's is on the Right.

**What to Bring:** Bring plenty of water, camera, hiking boots; comfortable hiking clothes and a hat.

**Overview:** This is a delightful, 6-mile loop trail. Starting from the end of Lee Canyon Road or from near McWilliams Campground, the trail winds around the upper reaches of Lee Canyon passing through Pine-Fir Forests, groves of Quaking Aspen, and a Bristlecone Pine forest. There are great views of the surrounding mountain peaks, the ski area, and down Lee Canyon. If you walk the entire 5-mile trail, it takes about 1 mile of paved road to close the loop (a use-trail can be used to short-cut the highway switchbacks).

A fence was built along the start of the trail at the upper trailhead in 2007 that is intended to protect rare plants and the rare butterfly species that lives on the plants. The plant grows here and only in a few other places around Mt. Charleston. Please respect the fence, stay on the trail, and help protect these rare species.

**After the Hike:** This hike usually only takes a couple of hours. So, how about a picnic in the Meadow below the campground afterward?? Kick your shoes off under the shade tree and enjoy a beautiful July afternoon out of the heat of the city with your fellow hikers.
