# News to Me

These are things you should **NOT** do in the first 48 to 72 hours after a ski injury. They are called the HARM factors:

**Heat:** Increases swelling and bleeding. Avoid heat packs, hot baths and saunas.

**Alcohol:** Increases swelling and bleeding. Plus, it can delay healing.

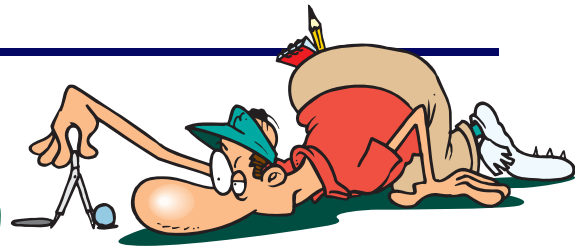
**Running or Exercise:** Aggravates the injury which increases pain, swelling and bleeding. Always check with a health professional before resume sport or exercise.

**Massage:** Increases swelling and bleeding. Direct massage to the injured area may aggravate the damaged tissues and is normally best avoided for the first 48 to 72 hours.

Indirect massage (away from the injury site) may be helpful. Please consult your health practitioner for the best advice for your injury.

**What should you do?  
Rest, Elevate and Ice**

1. Risk of injury from the activity and equipment utilized is significant including the potential for broken bones, severe injuries to the head, neck, and back or other bodily injuries that my result in permanent disability and death.
2. Possible equipment failure and/or malfunction or misuse of my own or others' equipment.
3. **I AGREE THAT I WILL WEAR APPROVED PROTECTIVE GEAR AS DECREED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE SPORT I AM PARTICIPATING IN.** However, protective gear cannot guarantee the participant's safety. 5. My own negligence and/or the negligence of others, including but not limited to operator error and guide decision making including misjudging terrain, weather, riding surfaces or other obstacles.
