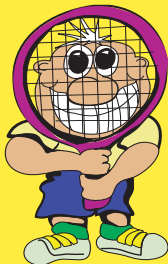

Salt Lake City

December 6TH to 9TH

Trip Price is: **\$179.00**

This trip will be a carbon copy of the well-received trip we did the last 3 years. We have available to us the 4 Ski Areas that are tucked away in both Little Cottonwood and Big Cottonwood Canyons right on the outskirts of Salt Lake City. These are Snowbird, Alta, Solitude and Brighton. A little further away are 3 more areas, that our members have expressed an interest in, which include Canyons, Park City, and Deer Valley. Still further down the road, but within reach is Snow Basin, which was one of the main Olympic venues for the 2002 Games. We won't decide exactly where we are going to ski till we get there. That way everyone gets a say and we can look at such things as weather, snow conditions, etc. Since this is a Carpool trip we will have multiple vehicles there and we can divide up and go to multiple areas if that is what the participants want. Nothing is set in stone.

What is included:

- 3 Nights Lodging at the Days Inn (based on dbl. occupancy) These are clean, spacious hotel rooms each equipped with a small refrigerator, microwave, coffee maker, hair dryer & iron.
- Transportation - Las Vegas to/from Salt Lake City (Transportation will be by Carpool. Gas cost is included in the trip price.) Note: The drivers/vehicle providers will have their part of the gas covered by the remaining trip participants as a part of the \$179.00 trip price. This means their trip price will be reduced by about \$50.00.
- Transportation to and from the Ski Areas Remember we carpoled so we have multiple vehicles to get us to the Ski Areas, Restaurants, Stores, Micro-breweries, etc. (Gas was budgeted for this in the trip price.)

Overview: This is a moderate, 1.5-mile hike to the top of Cathedral Rock, a rocky promontory with great views overlooking Kyle Canyon. It winds through thick patches of Aspen and evergreens. The trail follows an old road up an avalanche chute along the east side of Cathedral Rock to a saddle behind the summit. From there, the trail climbs a few short switchbacks to the summit. The views from the summit are spectacular: you can see straight down to the picnic area and the lodge, and you can see off to the other peaks in the area, including Mt. Charleston, Mummy Mountain, Mary Jane Falls and the Sheep Range.
