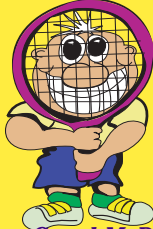

# Raintree/Mummy Springs Hike

*This Mt. Charleston hike starts at the North Loop Trailhead for approximately 3 miles to the Raintree/Mummy Springs Junction.  
\*Moderate/Strenuous, 6 miles.*

**When:** Saturday, September 20, 2008

**When/Where to Meet:** 8:00 am at the McDonalds at 95 and Craig Road. We will be car pooling from McDonalds.

**What to Bring:** Plenty of water, camera, hiking boots and wear comfortable hiking clothes.

**After the Hike:** For those who want to, we will stop and have a mid-day snack somewhere yet to be determined . . .

**Overview:** (Thanks to birdandhike.com) From the trailhead the trail runs into the forest on a clearly marked and well-maintained trail. Initially, the trail is fairly gentle and passes through a forest of tall ponderosa pines. This is where the strenuous part comes in. There is a 1500 ft elevation gain obtained through a series (approx 2 miles) of very steep switchbacks. The trail climbs onto a flat ridgetop referred to as "the viewpoint." From the viewpoint, the trail switchbacks steeply up a forested hillside towards a highpoint on the ridge east of the Mummy's Toes. This trail junction is watched over by the fabled "Raintree," an enormous old bristlecone pine that is said to be some 3,000 years old. From the Raintree, the Mummy Spring trail runs north, drops off the ridge, and traverses the slopes beneath the Mummy's feet and ankles. The trail passes through a dense forest of bristlecone pines for 0.3 miles (10 minutes) to a wide gully. The gully is swept by avalanches during winter, so only aspen, shrubs, and grasses grow in the gully. This will be our turn around point.
