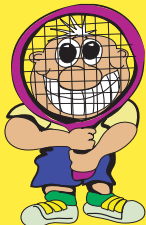

Director's Column

It shouldn't cost THAT MUCH!!!

Have you ever wondered, "What happens to my dues money? I don't seem to get anything for it. Is it being wasted by the BOD or used to subsidize ski trips that I don't even go on? Is it spent supporting activities that don't pay for themselves?" Well, the real answer lies in the cost of doing business.

Wanting to project costs for the coming year to determine how well we are managing expenses for the ski club, I did some research into past expenses. After collecting and analyzing the data, one thing was clear: LVSSC spends a considerable amount of money keeping its members informed of club activities.

Some of the larger fixed costs include: Telephone, Yellow Pages advertisement, Web master, Web-hosting, Newsletter Editor, Newsletter printing, Newsletter mailing, credit card processing, and liability insurance.

Collectively, coming in at about \$500 a month or \$6000 a year are the newsletter, phone hotline, and website. Although these forms of communication are all necessary to provide you with up-to-date information of upcoming activities, **they are not free**. In order to reduce these costs, the BOD recently voted to stop mailing paper copies of the newsletter, which cost about \$1 each after printing and mailing costs, saving about \$75 a month or \$900 per year.

There are also some incidental club costs such as stationary and postage for other club mailings and tax return preparation and affiliation dues.

Some of the other expenses that we incur on a regular basis are for the social activities; this may include meeting expenses and prizes, and the occasional plaque for departing members. Normally, all these costs amount to about \$40 per month for an annual total of \$480. The grand total is \$6480 per year (\$29 per member).

Another large expense which is easily overlooked by most members is the cost of liability insurance, which is about \$2500 a year, or \$11 per member.

As you can see, the basic costs account for nearly \$40 of your \$45 annual membership fee.

So, now you know what happens to all that dues money.

September Hike to Cathedral Rock, Kyle Canyon

I don't think we could have asked for a more beautiful day, except that smoke from a wildfire hundreds of miles away, just north of Los Angeles, presented us with a dreamy, ethereal haze over the canyon. The distinct aroma of a crackling campfire left many of us wondering who had the marshmallows.

Lung-choking smoke aside, eight of us climbed the short 1.2 miles to the top of a jagged rock escarpment known as Cathedral Rock. From our lofty perch, we could see—well, very little. The smoke had limited our view to just a few hundred yards. We could see a slight indication of the changing Aspen on a distant slope, some of the residences below, and, if we really squinted, Mt. Charleston itself. But, we are a hardy bunch, and our enthusiasm did not falter. We took the obligatory group photo shot atop the peak, sans one who wandered off to commune with nature on his own, and began our decent down the hill.

On the way down, we took a little side trip to a usually flowing stream and waterfall. Alas, not today. The fall was dry. A few inquisitive hikers scrambled up the rocky sides of the reservoir only to find it woefully dry also. Dismayed, but not defeated, we turned to make our way back to the main trail. Do you ever get that feeling that someone is watching you, but you can't quite figure out who and where? Just as we were leaving the falls, some of the group in the back of the pack heard a "strange" rustling noise. Since we were the only ones in the area, this caused a little concern. They stopped to investigate and lo and behold, bringing up the rear was a herd of mule deer, out for a midday snack. We were fascinated with their total disregard for our intrusion. Exact number of deer is up for debate, but estimates ranged from 6 to possibly 8 of them roaming the hillside. Pictures were taken, oohs and aaahs were expressed, and we left the deer to dine in peace.

The Upper Lodge of the Mt Charleston Resort seemed the perfect place to recount our adventure as well as re-tell our own past interludes in the Mt.

Charleston wilderness. The consensus was that, despite the smoke, the hike was a great success and we're all looking forward to the next one.

October's hike will take us back to Red Rock Canyon where we will explore Ice Box Canyon. Hope to see you there!

This trip will be a carbon copy of the well-received trip we did the last 3 years. We have available to us the 4 Ski Areas that are tucked away in both Little Cottonwood and Big Cottonwood Canyons right on the outskirts of Salt Lake City. These are Snowbird, Alta, Solitude and Brighton. A little further away are 3 more areas, that our members have expressed an interest in, which include Canyons, Park City, and Dear Valley. Still further down the road, but within reach is Snow Basin, which was one of the main Olympic venues for the 2002 Games. We won't decide exactly where we are going to ski till we get there. That way everyone gets a say and we can look at such things as weather, snow conditions, etc. Since this is a Carpool trip we will have multiple vehicles there and we can divide up and go to multiple areas if that is what the participants want. Nothing is set in stone.

What is included:

- 3 Nights Lodging at the Days Inn (based on dbl. occupancy) These are clean, spacious hotel rooms each equipped with a small refrigerator, microwave, coffee maker, hair dryer & iron.
- Transportation - Las Vegas to/from Salt Lake City (Transportation will be by Carpool. Gas cost is included in the trip price.) Note: The drivers/vehicle providers will have their part of the gas covered by the remaining trip participants as a part of the \$179.00 trip price. This means their trip price will be reduced by about \$50.00.
- Transportation to and from the Ski Areas Remember we carpoled so we have multiple vehicles to get us to the Ski Areas, Restaurants, Stores, Micro-breweries, etc. (Gas was budgeted for this in the trip price.)
