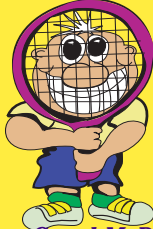

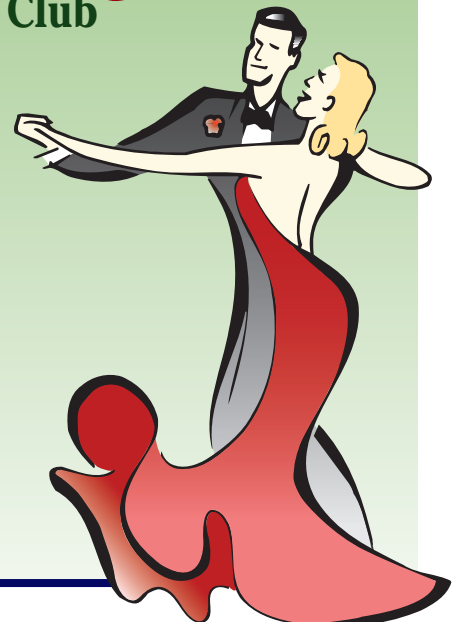

Fletcher Canyon Trail Hike

Mt Charleston hike to Fletcher Canyon.

Pleasant, easy, through rugged cliffs and a narrow canyon to a seasonal spring.

- Easy
- Approximately 3.5 miles round trip
- 1100 ft elevation gain.
- 2-3 hours hike time

When: Saturday, October 18, 2008

When/Where to Meet: 8:00 am at the McDonalds at Rancho & Craig Road.

What to Bring: We will be car pooling from McDonalds. Water, camera, hiking boots; comfortable hiking clothes**

***This is a late season hike into the Spring Mountains. Weather is very unpredictable at this time of year. I would suggest you layer your clothing accordingly.*

Overview: *(thanks to localhikes.com)*

Very easy, enjoyable hike which begins surrounded by pinyon pines, manzanita and mountain mahogany. The trail is fairly level. You walk along the dry creek bed as you head deep into Fletcher Canyon. When you reach the large dead tree lying across the washbed next to the trail you've walked 1 mile. You will cross the streambed (several paths) with little water seeping (seasonal) and follow a foot path climbing up as the canyon walls narrow and you enter a slot canyon filled with living trees, ferns, wild roses; as well as debris (logs, rocks) washed down by flash floods. You will eventually dead-end at obstacle rock.
