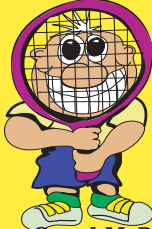

Director's Column

Will You be Ready this Winter Season?

You may be working hard getting yourself in shape for the up coming ski season, but don't forget to have your skis or snowboard tuned and your bindings checked before that first day on the snow. The season is just around the corner and the shop line may be long in a couple of months.

Not only does everybody get a good laugh at the expense of the person dragging rusted skis all the way to the lift line, but it can make for some tough skiing. All of sudden, those rocks you ran over during your last run in the spring will come back to haunt you. When was the last time you had those bindings set to your current weight? Perhaps you've lost a few pounds or added a few on. Have your bindings set to your current weight so releases or non-releases do not cause injury. Check your poles. How are the baskets and straps? As for your ski boots check your buckles for wear and replace broken pieces if possible.

To put your mind at ease, it is well worth the trip to your favorite ski shop to let the pros tune your bases and adjust your bindings. With this in mind, I'm setting up an appointment with McGhie's here in Las Vegas. McGhie's, located on Ft. Apache and Flamingo in Las Vegas, is a fully stocked ski, snowboard and ski apparel shop. It also has a reputation as a trusted professional ski service center and is a great place for a pre-season tune up for skis and bindings. McGhie's offers a 15% discount on all shop work and unlimited free Ski Waxes to card carrying members of the Las Vegas Ski and Sports club.
